I'm not a dance music sort of a guy. But I am a RocKFiscH sort of a guy. These guys take mega dance hits; hit them hard, with their own flavor to them, medley almost everything and they make it work

Dance floor was packed. Band is not only good, they are animated; they leave the stage and wander around, dance with people while playing, even come sit at your table and play. The three across the front play various instruments, all sing lead, harmonize perfectly, swap leads, and put on a show. It's hard to define. When they do black dance songs they sound black, when they do white dance songs they sound white and everything sounds funky.
